

**ROWAN COUNTY HOMEMAKERS  
COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP**

- 1. A scholarship of \$750.00 will be awarded each year. A student is eligible for the scholarship one time only.**
- 2. Student must be a resident of Rowan County, senior at Rowan County Senior High School, Rowan County Private School, or a home school graduate by the end of the current school year.**
- 3. Males and females are both eligible.**
- 4. Student must be enrolled as a full time student during that calendar year at a Kentucky college or university.**
- 5. Applicant must have three written recommendations - one from a guidance counselor, one from a high school teacher, and one from a clergyman or other community leader.**
- 6. A high school transcript must be submitted.**
- 7. Recipient is requested to attend the County Homemaker Annual Meeting in April to meet members and be recognized. The check will not be presented at the Annual meeting. The money will be sent to the college or university in the fall after the student's enrollment has been verified by the Homemaker Association treasurer.**
- 8. Applicant must fill out application completely and in their own handwriting.**
- 9. Recipient may pursue any course of study.**
- 10. Applications must be turned in to the Rowan County Extension Office by April 1. The Extension Office address is: 600 West Main Street, Morehead, KY 40351. Must be received by the first working day of April by 4:00 P.M. No exceptions.**
- 11. Application forms may be obtained from guidance counselors or the Extension Office (located in the courthouse).**
- 12. Availability of the scholarship will be publicized through the Rowan County Senior High School guidance counselors, the Rowan County High School Senior sponsors, Private schools, and in the local media.**
- 13. Decision will be made by the Rowan County Homemaker Scholarship Selection Committee.**
- 14. All information will be kept confidential.**
- 15. Applicants will be evaluated based on financial need, character, performance in school, extracurricular activities and desire to continue education based on information provided on the application form.**
- 16. Applicants should attach a hand-written letter addressed to the committee stating why they would like to receive the scholarship.**





3. A letter of recommendation from one of your high school teachers, concerning academic achievement, character, potential and financial need.
4. A hand-written letter from you, telling why you are applying for this scholarship, why you feel you are deserving of the scholarship, and of the financial need you possess. Also, tell of your plans for college and how the scholarship will be used. Please explain any unusual family circumstances which have a bearing on family financial support for you and college. Include such items as unusual illness, misfortune, and other pertinent information.
